Strategic collaboration and governance

Total funding commitments – over \$4 million

We are working together to maintain and build on Hobart's vibrancy, liveability and amenity, as we welcome more people to our City.

There are two governance structures linked to the Hobart City Deal that will run in parallel with complementary roles:

- the Hobart City Deal governance monitors and reports on the implementation of the Deal
- the Greater Hobart Act governance leads the implementation of some actions identified in the Deal, as well as having a broader integrated planning and ongoing decision making role as Greater Hobart grows.

Both governance structures support the Hobart City Deal vision, and will drive and encourage cross-government collaboration.

Actions

Greater Hobart Act and supporting regulations to provide an enduring framework for collaborative decision making between state and local government.

Develop a Metro Plan to inform an urban Greater Hobart update of the Southern Tasmania Regional Land Use Strategy.

Support the **implementation of the Hobart City Deal** through maintaining the governance structures and engagement by all parties.

Measure of success

Within the term of the Hobart City Deal:

- The Greater Hobart Act will be established and City Deal Partners will be actively implementing an agreed, strategic work program
- Greater Hobart councils will have benefitted from coordinated strategic decision making and investment.
